Position Summary:

The Bell Choir Director is responsible for selecting music and rehearsing the choir to provide bell music during Sanctuary worship, in consultation with and under the supervision of the Director of Music and the Pastor. This is a part-time position for approximately 15-20 hours per month. Salary commensurate with experience

Qualifications/Characteristics:

- Experience in organizing and directing handbells
- Good people skills; cooperative and outgoing, enthusiastic and energetic.
- Organizational skills for planning and purchasing music.
- Knowledge of Christian worship demonstrating the ability to select appropriate handbell music.
- Committed Christian dedicated to offering praise and glory to God through music.

Responsibilities:

- Mentor and develop the spiritual and musical growth of handbell ringers
- Oversee maintenance of handbells and handbell music library
- Recruit and rehearse handbell members
- Conduct and play during the worship services as scheduled.
- Administer handbell funds to purchase music, equipment, and repairs in communication with the Director of Music
- Supervise movement of handbell equipment on or off church property
- Confer with the Pastor and Director of Music on a regular basis to integrate the bell program in planning worship services.
